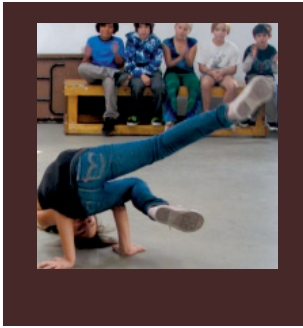
Very Cool Videography

We will make prisms, sun prints, kaleidoscopes, additive color wheels, work with glitter and sequins, and paint with bubbles.

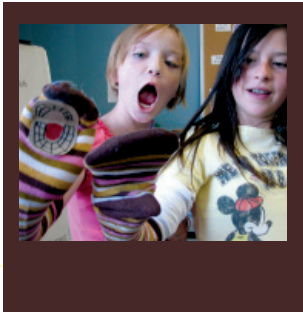
Bangles, Baubles and Beads!

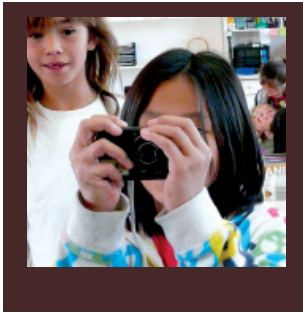
